**Tuition:** \$120/monthly beginning with the September payment and ending with the May payment. Tuition is computed on a school year basis and divided by 9 months, so that you pay the same amount each month regardless of the number of days. There are no tuition reductions for holidays, illness, or other absence. \*If a child is withdrawn, a thirty-day notice must be given. No refund will be given when withdrawing a student. Tuition is due on the first of each month, cash, check, AFCU transfer, or Venmo. Please make checks out to Christel Chamberlain. A \$10 late fee will incur after the 5th . A child will be withdrawn from Smarty Pants for non-payment of tuition.
